It was unfortunate that drinking water facilities as W.No 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 are not sufficient & it needs very much improvement, for that P.H.E deptt should ensure that these wards must get drinking water facilities regularly. L.T.C wires & Electricity poles are reqd in the village panchayat as most of the complaints were written in B2V2, & 3, Need to be redressed as early as possible. One cracked building at GMS Katti is unsafe & need urgent (repair or dismantled) & upgradation of GMS Katti & GMS Pallian Katti to H/S. Anganwadi centre's should be opened at W.No 4, 5, 6, 7. All deptt's are working in liason with PRI members but has to redressed the public complaints as soon as possible. I am lucky enough to visit village Lamsora & interacted with PRI members villager's & Govt officials & instructed them all to work jointly for the upgradation of village PVT Lamsora.
