## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

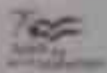

## Public Grievances

### **A. High Secondary School-Panthal**

1. The Building under Construction by REMSA has only one room at 1st Floor, the people and the staff are requesting for completion/construction for whole floor.
2. Toilet: No Separate toilet for Men and Women. Moreover, proper Maintenance of these Toilets also needs to be done.
3. No Boundary School at High School Panthal and it requires to be constructed.
4. Study of Commerce is not available at High School, as such People are requesting to start Study of commerce at High School.
5. One of the Building at High School is in very poor conditions and also declared unsafe by R&B-PWD Reasi Division as reported by Principal. The staff has informed that they had communicated with higher Authorities Like CEO. However, no action was taken. Accordingly, the CEO Smt. Sunita Bali was contacted over phone given by the visiting officer and was intimated about danger of using the building and threat to the students studying there. The CEO has assured for looking into the matter.
6. No IT Teacher is available in whole school.
7. Lecturer of Political Science, English are required.

### **B. Middle School**

1. Primary School Devi Pindi-(Shrine Board Building)- The Building was in poor condition and need urgent repair to avoid any mis-happening. One of the Pillar there was about to collapse and the electric pole is located in centre of School and live wires are going over the roof of building which also needs to be replaced to avoid any mis-happening. All this things were communicated to CEO through proper Channel but nothing has been done in this matter.
2. No Boundary Wall in the school.
3. No Drinking Water.
4. No Urdu teacher on regular Basis.

### **C. New Primary School Panthal-** The School has no building of its own but being run in Middle School Panthal which is under Baghta Panchayat.

### **D. Power Development Department**

1. Up gradation of Wire are urgently required, The sagging wires are also close to the ground (in some case just 8-10 feet above ground) which result in frequent power failure.
2. Electric Poles are also required to replaced/installed.
3. At present there is 3 feeder (02 no. -63 KV and 01 no. 100 KV). Electricity is coming from feeder Sughal Ghati. As such, demand of people is to provide them fresh feeder for kun-kanyala to have better supply of Electricity.

### **E. Youth Club**

1. There is no playground in the entire Panchayat. Moreover, there are two dangals which were held for last 100 Years but no Land was available.

However, Villagers are ready to give their 5 Kanals of Land for the Purpose of Playground . But the same was required to be maintained by the respective Department.

**F. ICDS Department**

1. The salaries to the Angadwari Workers were not given to them. The Share of UT of J&K of Rs 1050 was not given to them since January 2022 and of Centre of Rs 4000 since March 2022.

**G. Social and Welfare Department**

The Old age Pension and Widow Pension were not given to the beneficiaries for last 3 months.

**H. Irrigation Department**

Area of Panthal Irrigation needs to be shifted from MIDD-Dharmandi to PHE Division Reasi and also to Convert PHE Division into Hydraulic Division.

**I. Roads and Bridges**

1. Building adjacent to BDO Office is incomplete Since 12 Years.
2. Middle School at Kun-Kanarya is also under Construction Since 8 Years.
3. Bridge to be constructed over Railway crossing at Ward no. 8 of Panthal, which poses serious threat to the life of the people living there. Further, it was informed that in recent times an accident was occurred in which a person lost his complete flock of sheep .
4. The road from Naseeb Singh House to Saribadi (Near Kabristan, Around 300-400 m in length, As of now no track is there. Villagers are requesting for making Track (Pacca Track) (around 8-10 feet wide) . Moreover, Villagers are agreed to give their land for this purpose.

**J. Food Supplies**

1. Out of 2 shops (PDS) one is in on rent basis. The rent was collected from Ration Card Holder @Rs 30 per card. As such, people are requesting for Govt. Shop.
2. Camps are required to be held for correction of errors, issuance of New Cards.
3. Issues of non-issuance of BPL Card is also raised by the Villagers.

**K. Tourism/Tourist Area**

**Devi Pindi**


1. Home stay to be created.
2. Track to be improved.
3. Toilets to be created for both Male and Female.
4. Tourist pollute the fresh water stream/Jajjar Nallah which is the main source of drinking water to entire Panthal and surrounding areas even Katra. As such, people are requesting the respective Department to look into the matter.
5. Shrine Board to be created for Dev Pindi as appox. 40-50 thousand pilgrims visit the shrine annually for betterment of Shrine.

6. Elected representative are requesting to Construct Green Track from Shankracharya temple Katra to Shrine Dev Pindi to encourage Tourism in the area.
