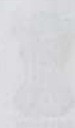

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
5. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

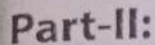
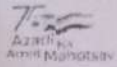

* Observations by the visiting officer: (SHAHGUND - C)

(1) The area is facing severe water problem. Following steps may be taken:

- (a) Replacement of drinking water pipelines.
- (b) Desilting of canals
- (c) work should be started for Amrit sarovar
- (d) OHT projects may be expedited
- (e) A chinar tree in the compound of Shukrudin Shahgund Filtration Plant is causing hindrances for the project, besides adding litter to water. Adequate solution needs to be found in this regard. The plant further needs lighting facilities, which may be considered.

(6) The pump station at Khumina needs a new pump as the old one is around 60 years old and dysfunctional. vertical Pump is preferable over horizontal one.

(2) Anganwadi network needs to be expanded as there is serious space crunch. Furthermore, Anganwadis workers may be paid adequately and on time.

(3) PM Awas Yojana beneficiaries need to be provided with rent installments immediately so as to complete the construction work. These families are living in Tin Sheds currently and may face many issues in the harsh winter ahead.

4) The ISM dispensary needs:

(a) Allopathic consultant

(b) Diagnostic lab (The space already exists)

5) The J&N Bank Branch needs Human Resources, net banking facilities and most importantly an ATM.




