

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- 5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
- 7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
- 8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas
- a. Make full use of Centrally Sponsored Schemes
- b. Saturation of individual beneficiary schemes
- Self-employment schemes
- d. Bank linked schemes-including departmental subsidy schemes





General Assessment of the visiting Officer

A. Overall Assessment

Overall visit to the panchayat remained satisfactory. The panchayat has already reached saturation of some of the schemes such as old age pension, widow pension, disability pension and have shown good progress in other schemes. The concerned departments have been sensitized and advised to take initiative and ensured at all the schemes and taken to saturation level in time bound manner. All the agenda points kept for Day 1 and 2 were properly managed and attended. The quality of the work executed by the panchayat was satisfactory. The panchayat has good potential for sports but lacks sports infrastructure and even single physical education teacher is not available in whole panchayat. The internal roads are not in good shape.

i was visiting officer to this panchayat during B2V1. As per record, the issues raised / came up for discussion during B2V1, B2V2, B2V3 have remained almost same. Though some action has aiready been taken by the panchayat / concerned departments yet some important issues that need intervention at higher level remained unresolved and again raised in the meeting with PRIs and in Gram Sabha also. These issues are:

- 1. Two prestigious institutions i.e. IIT Jammu and IIM Jammu have been established / being established in Jagti panchayat. Huge construction work is going on in both the institutions. The public has some genuine issues with the institutions in general and with construction agencies in particular, such as, the construction waste (Mulba) is not being managed properly and as a result the agriculture land adjoining to these construction sites is being damaged every day. It has been reported / observed also that the sewerage treatment is not being done properly by the institutions which is causing hygienic issues and health hazards to the locals. Besides, the easement rights of the some of the locals have also been hampered in the absence of proper alternate pathways / approaches to the private land. The public has to pass through the national highway for even small agriculture works, which has caused many accidents in the past.
- 2. Satellite town Jagti constructed for Kashmiri migrants also falls in the Panchayat. There is no proper solid waste management system for this Township. The Solid / liquid waste is seen thrown just outside the township which is again a source of health hazard for the public of the panchayat. The panchayat informed that the issue was raised with the officers of the Relief Organization and various other forums yet the problem has not been solved.
- There are approximate 22 natlahs pass through the panchayat and the continuous /regular soil erosion has darnaged the agricultural land to a great extent. A proper project is required to be prepared for the Panchayat to save the left over land.



B. Suggestions:

- It is suggested that in order to resolve the issues of the panchayat with institutions (IIT, IIM and Migrant Colony) a meeting at higher level, either at of the PRI.
- 2. Besides, a comprehensive plan / project is required to be prepared and executed to address the issue of soil erosion. A large part of the Jagti panchayat land resource has already been acquired by IIT, IIM, National Highway, Ring road & Jagti Township (Migrant colony). The large scale construction has exposed the soil for easy erosion. The leftover land is under the constant threat of the erosion. The panchayat may not be in position to take up the project due to their limited resources and technical knowhow.
