Road connectivity | Electricity in the franchayat was also a major usue highlighted by the locals during B204. Construction of Bridge and road on ruver tawn and the blacktopping of soad from latti to jakked is also demanded.

Although Govt Hr. Sed School Jakhal in working very well under the able leadwiship of Principal Modam and dedicated staff Ind due to deficit staff is less than 50% the Sanctioned Ishength, the students as well as the parents are foring probleme. Lack of infrastructure as well as boundary wall is also a by the raised by the school management which needs to be addressed immediately.
