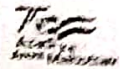

① Major Complaint brought to the notice of visiting officer:

①

① During Public meeting, it was brought to the notice that unemployed youth are facing difficulties for availing Bank loans for self employment, as they are not in a position to complete the credit formalities due to non availability of resources / Economic Condition.

② During visit to Public Health centre, the people. Complaint about the non availability of any Sanctioned Post for Doctor. Although the Public Health Centre was well maintained but There is shortage of Doctors.

③ People demanded establishment of Ration depot at Qazitorian village, as they have to cover  $2\frac{1}{2}$  kms distance to reach Ration depot which is available at Mash Bagh.

④ There is a demand for construction of Pond at Harshatopran under Amul Sarovar.

⑤ People have shown dissatisfaction regarding working of Revenue dept. In this regard 4/5/22 visited The office of Fa Naib Tehsildar who was on leave due to health issues.

⑥ People demand construction of bridge to reach Cremation ground at Qazitorian. They feel difficulty in crossing the water logged area to reach cremation ground.

The problem of Public transport still prevails.

(2) Installation of Transformers have done but load has not been divided which cause voltage fluctuation especially at Qazitorian village.

(3) The work of Community hall construction at Panchayat Ghar is still pending due to non-availability of funds

(4) Cremation ground at Qazitorian is still without boundary wall. People have demanded construction of bridge for crossing pond to reach cremation ground.

(5) Drainage system is still unaddressed at many places

(6) Bathing Ghat at village Chak Jaffer was constructed during B<sub>2</sub>V<sub>3</sub>, but tiling work is has still not completed due to lack of funds.

## Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions <sup>3</sup>

The undersigned visited Panchayat Mah Halqua and made interaction with officers/officials of various govt. deptt and Public in general besides various members of P.R.s. Following overall assessment has been recorded regarding the present scenario of Panchayat Mah Halqua:

- 1) Lack of proper co-ordination among people which hinders the development process.
- 2) There is need to establish Playground cum Park for children and old people for recreational purpose. This is as per the demand of the people.
- 3) Regular Doctors not available at Primary Health center. As there is no sanctioned post of Doctor as reported by BMO.
- 4) Drainage channels are constructed but due to negligence of people, these channels are found to be blocked posing drainage problems.
- 5) Co-ordination of Revenue deptt with general public is required to sort out various issues of the public.
- 6) Education system is satisfactory. Schools both primary as well as High Schools are functioning properly with healthy Mid-day-meal.
- 7) Construction of cremation ground is required. besides bathing place for women at Harshatoprian
