The V.O. conducted a Thorough visit to the Village Panchayat Halga Gobra - A along with the Sarpanch and other Frontline workers.

The Panchayat has received a lot of Funds and utilised properly especially under MGNREGA and RDS. There is shortage water supply in the area and needs immediate attention from the concerned. For Self Employment scheme a Jan adhyak is needed for assisting the people with the deliverable schemes and items. The area is flood prone during rainy season and therefore need flood protection work at different stages. The Terebin Farthamare patur-Khane building is immediate need of the Panchayat Halga.
