(iii) a) * Higher Secondary School Vadpore

- Staff shortage at higher level (i.e. lecturers). Accommodation not sufficient for many classes (adjoining kitchen); some building work only have four walls, but without slab and roof (open upper side); No laboratory and no library.
- The playground (demanded by the students enrolled there);

- b) * Primary school Gammie Mahalla: Keeping the location, topography and terrain into consideration, the small, eroded, but good needed to be upgraded. Electricity not available.

- c) * UPS (Minimal electricity) → Building used for teaching learning process looks highly graded (major cracks), unsafe for students. Location being at outskirts of the village needs proper fencing for its premises.

(iv) * Swachh (SBM)

- It is a very good initiative, for creating a healthy and hygienic community. It focuses on clean environment. To make society free from numerous effects of toxic and contaminated substance.
- Certain cleanliness drives have been conducted by the concerned PDS along with local to create the awareness among the masses regarding health and hygiene.
