During my visit I came across many problems & some suggestions which I found out need urgent attention. Following suggestions need urgent attention:

- ① Const. of Panchayat Ghar (land available)
- ② Const. of Aagamwadi Building (land available)
- ③ Setting up of New water Pipe line from Tubewell w. No. 4 to Ashram.
- ④ Const. of Link Road from Lower Masgal to Upper Masgal.
- ⑤ Const. of Community Hall near Mata Mandir.
- ⑥ Const. of Bathing Gher for women at Cremation Ground.
(Problem has been raised time and again in B₂V₁, B₂V₂ & B₂V₃.)
- ⑦ Const. of Road to Cremation Ground.
- ⑧ Const. of Toilet & water Tank at Mata Mandir.
