





GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

General Assessment of the Visiting Officer

1. Any major Complaint brought to the notice of the visiting officer:

1. Bunkers have been constructed in the Panchayat. However, masonry has not provided over entrance due to which these bunkers get filled with water during rainy season.
2. Tubewell provided for irrigation purpose are defunct since long time and no action been taken by the department.
3. Although, water canal is running through the village. But there is no water at tail end of canal to meet the requirement of water for irrigation despite charging for the same.
4. Regarding land compensation for land occupied for defence use.

5. Requirement to augment tubewells / repair tubewells / supplying sufficient water in canal for irrigation purpose. As agriculture is primary source of the village.

3. Overall assessment of the visit & suggestions.

As per interaction with people of Panchayat Jabawal, there is a dire need of dispensary / sub centre / PHC as it is not feasible during late hours / at time of shelling to visit centres located in nearby panchayats.

Also, due to non-availability of public transport, students face difficulty to travel in other panchayats for study purpose, as only 01 govt GPS available in Jabawal.

Almost, all households in Ppt having cattle, due to absence of veterinary centre, it is difficult everytime to take their cattles in other panchayats for medical checkup.

There is a requirement of playground for overall development of the children in the panchayat.

Being totally dependent on agriculture, there is a need to augment irrigation sources in the panchayat for more productivity such as repairing of defunct tubewells, sufficient water supply in irrigation canal.







