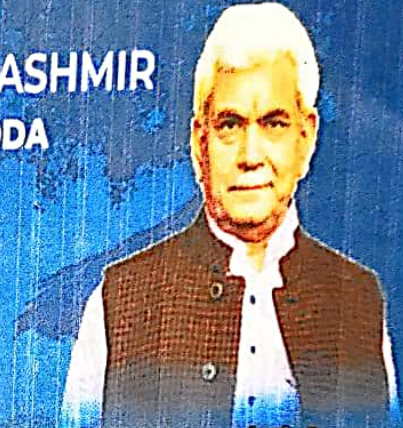

Overall Assessment of the visit

My visit in the Panchayat Chakka-A-1 is during B2V4 remains satisfactory. High School Chakka functioning well but according to the strength of students building is not sufficient, as there is need of a building complex for school. Other U.P.S. Kundi and two primary schools are good in all respects.

- Panchayat needs shifting of office of Sheep husbandry in their Panchayat as this office is functioning in another Panchayat because it is sanctioned on the name of Chakka-Kundi Panchayat.
- No road connectivity to Chakka is the major issue. So it is demand of the Panchayat to sanction a app. 3 km. road from Tangal Dhat to H.S. Chakka.
- People of Village Reena, Beroow, Tund, Dadas, Goward, Sheldar, Ganoon, Kuntwah and Dugha want new halqa Panchayat as Reena - Beroow. Because Panchayat Chakka-A-1 is geographically much more in length and it is very difficult for adm. as well as for local representatives to fulfill the basic requirements in-habitants.
