GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

A big chunk of Kurhama village is not covered under pure water supply scheme. The area does not have well macadamized roads although it was declared as the best among the 3 villages of Ganderbal. Area demands ATM facility & renovation of school building.

II Major/urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- 1 Dearth of staff in PHC Kurhama is a major and most urgent demand of the locals. As inspected & verified the PHC being equipped X-Ray & Dental Labs but due to dearth of staff they are useless.
- 2 To provide land for the playground. The same land was donated by the people of Kurhama to CUK in the past.

III Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:

The major chunk of the population, which have had horizontal and vertical migration lack proper drinking water facility.. The electric poles are not installed in every nook and corner.

A new water supply schemes (annexed in GPDP), maintenance and extension of the old water supply scheme are a priority to reach out to the common masses.

Renovation of school buildings is a must.

TO NEUTRALIZE THE DEARTH OF STAFF STRENGTH AT PHC KURHAMA IS AT THE TOP PRIORITY. The people also demanded greater cooperation from all line departments.

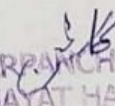
