In reference to the subject cited above it is submitted to your good self that:

1. We are the permanent residents of Ward No.1 of Panchayat Muthi Maira.

- Few months ago, a Drawbridge over a Khad flowing in our ward was sanctioned and constructed by the concerned department.
- w. constructed on its either side which makes it useless for the habitants. The above constructed drawbridge is narrow and the approaching or linking road or way was not
- 4 At the bus stop of our ward, the level of the linking dirt track or road is very much down from the main Macadamized road(Road with Black top) which creates uneasiness for the habitants during the rainy season and also during carrying a vehicle on that dirt track from the main road.
