

The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.

1. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
2. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflection, it under district/CSS plans
3. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
4. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that at least one PDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
5. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
6. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Panchayat besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Aadiyan and saturate them.
7. In addition attention may be given to the following areas:
 - a. Make full use of Centrally Sponsored Schemes
 - b. Saturation of individual beneficiary schemes
 - c. Self-employment schemes
 - d. Bank linked schemes- including departmental subsidy schemes
 - e. Empowerment and transparency through digital initiatives
 - f. Effectiveness of grass roots machinery -
 - i. Patwari, WUM present and available
 - ii. Available funds utilized in public interest and as per Gram Sabha resolutions
 - iii. Fairness in governance
 - iv. CSS/individual beneficiary schemes etc
 - v. Bhrashtachar Mukt JMK
 - vi. Btal Mukt JMK
 - vii. Nasha Mukt JMK

9. The PRI members (Sarpanchs, Panchs, BDC Chairperson) shall be at the forefront of all activities given due importance and the approach should be to strengthen them and make them empowered. He/she shall ensure that the BDC chairperson and Sarpanch/Panch are present at inauguration and ceremonies.
10. Visiting officer shall not leave the district without uploading the report, duly signed on **jkpanchayat.in** portal. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that.
