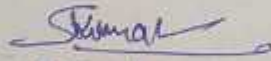

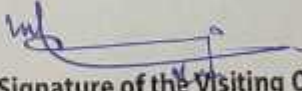

03. Overall Assessment of visit & suggestion

- Local public shows good response to Back to village programmes but the previous demand raised by public had not been yet solved & it leads negative feedback from local public. Panchayat is lead well by sarpanch & has full hope in short for overall development of this hilly & far flung panchayat.
- High school Chirda (feeding centre for various schools) & middle school lacks full staff & due to it quality of education hampers.
