Mahila sabha meeting was held today on 03-11-2022 at Panchayat Ghar in Panchayat Bhalwal lower in presence of visiting officer for B2V4 Mrs. Vinakshi Koul, JKAS, Deputy Labour Commissioner, Jammu. The Sabha was chaired by Sarpanch, Eng. Palavi Verma and attended by all the PRIs as well as the ladies from SHG, ICDS department and mahilas of the panchyat. The proceedings of the Sabha are listed below:-

1. The visiting officer stressed on the role of women in the society and how they can contribute in nation building by their active participation.
2. The various schemes run by the Government related to women were discussed in detail.
3. Self help groups were directed to involve more women in the village to increase the earnings in the panchayat. The story of one such SHG was discussed in which the women of the village are involved in turmeric cultivation in poly house on modern scientific lines (vertical gardening).
4. A stress was laid to check female students school dropout and increase the enrolment of female



students in schools.

5. Nutrition and health components were also discussed and stressed was laid to take the benefit of various facilities provided by the department of health, ICDS etc.
6. The women projected the issue regarding water scarcity in village Assurwan and demanded that the issue be resolved on priority basis. The visiting officer informed them that under Jal Jeevan Mission, a project of 276 lakh has already been prepared and tendering process for the same has been initiated.
7. The visiting officer emphasized that a calendar for conducting such Mahila Sabha meetings be prepared and the same should be made a regular feature to project the demands of the women folk in particular and of the community in whole.
8. The women were encouraged to tap their potential and avail the benefit of various schemes of the government for self employment and empowerment.

2. Awareness regarding drugs addiction in society was also created and were asked to stay away from drugs. The pledge was also taken in this regard.
3. Awareness regarding Swach Bharat Abhiyan and Aazadi ka Mahotsav was also carried out and children were made aware about their role in keeping the environment clean and green.
4. Student were encouraged to participate in sports activities both indoor and outdoor activities were carried out in which the children participated in different events like sac race, carom board, chess, etc. the children raised issued regarding non-availability of any sports grounds in their school and panchayat.
5. The children were encouraged to attend the school regularly with a view to check absentees and improve academics.
6. A talent hunt and cultural programme was also held in Government Degree College, Paloura where the visiting officer interacted with the youth and aware them about various self employment schemes, skill development courses under Himayat Scheme and encouraged them to avail benefit of such schemes. The youth raised the issue of non-availability of transport to the college and the problem of dumping site of municipality near the college which causes in convenience to the youth/ children and the faculty apart from the inhabitants of the area.

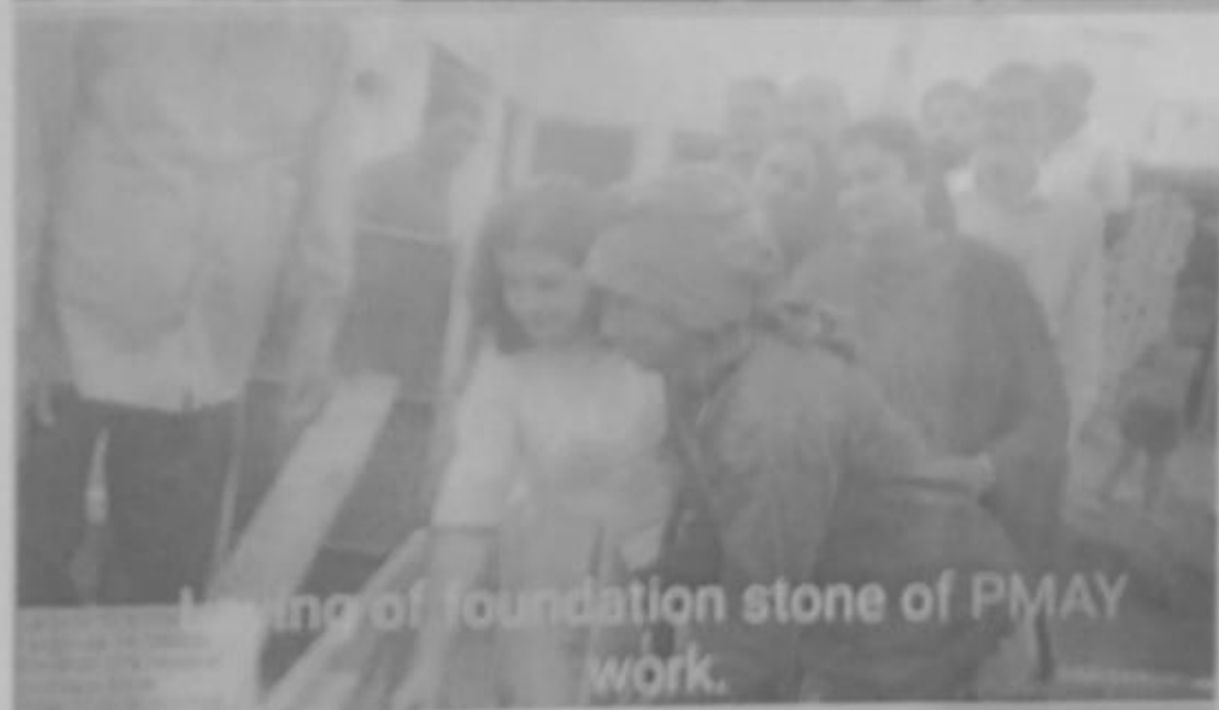
