1	In B2V1 People had demanded Doctor for PHC, the demand stand resolved ,Doctor has been posted and is working in the PHC from Last one year .	
2	In B2V1 ,B2V2 , B2V3,B2V4 people of the village had demanded insufficient drinking water , the problem stand resolved to a larger extent as presently 80% families are being provided Tap Water and JJM Officers assured that very soon 100% coverage will be ensured after commissioning of new scheme.	
3	In B2V3 and B2V4 , People had complained of irregular Power supply .the PDD department has improved by way of additional transformers but more needs to be done	
4	In previous Back to Village Programmes ,people of the village had demanded that interior roads , lanes of the village be developed .RDD department has done a remarkable work but a few roads and lanes need to be developed .	
5	In B2V2 , people of the village had demanded construction of a new PHC building , which has been taken up by Health Department and almost 90% work stands completed and rest 10% needs to be completed so that the building is put into use by the Health authorities.

D	Suggestions if any	
	1	Sanctioning of a new JK Bank Branch is dire need of the village. The people of the village have to travel to D H Pora for various banking services. This demand was put forth by the people in previous B2V Programmes also .
	2	Although the JJM department is claiming that tap water is being provided to almost 80% population but many villagers met me during my stay in the village and complained of the drinking water problem. Although Under JJM programme , a new Water supply scheme has been almost completed and upon its commissioning almost all the villagers will be connected to the Tap water facility. But upon enquiring from villagers and officials , there is some dispute between villagers regarding the functioning of water tanks which has hampered all the good initiative . The Civil administration , JJM Officers , PRI members and elders need to sit down and carve out some solution to the problem so that people are benefitted.
	3	In previous B2V programmes people of the area complained regarding power supply distribution . In the last Back to Village Programme we had also requested that worn out wires , damaged wooden poles need to be replaced and addition of few transformers will improve power supply position. The PDD department needs to look into the complaint of the people that at many places wire is being carried through trees which is danger for humans . It is suggested that worn out poles and wires need to be replaced with new ones and a few transformers added so that power supply will be improved.
	4	The Middle School Laispora which as per reports of the villagers has been shifted to Kounserbal needs to be restored back as the students of Laispora may feel incontinence to travel to Kounserbal for schooling .
	5	The construction of the Hospital building needs to be expedited so that the Health Department takes it over and people of the area are benefitted. Almost 90% of the work has been completed and the rest work needs to be completed.
