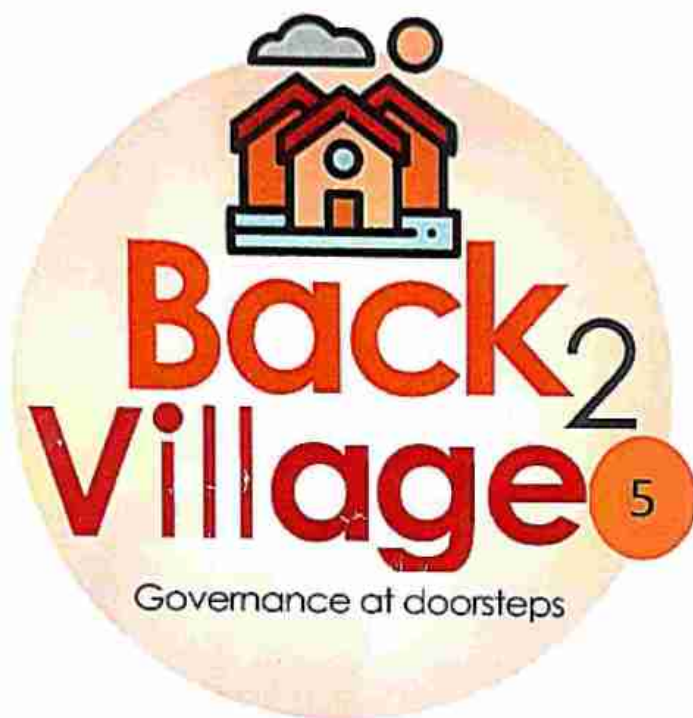

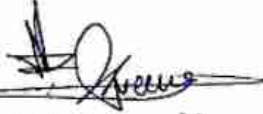

2. Play ground for children is required.
3. 02 No. of borewells are required. One at Amrit Sarovar and 2nd at W.No. 06.
4. Building for panchayat Ghar is required, Presently operating from Community Hall.
5. Common Service Centre + Village Library is required in the panchayat.
6. Veterinary Centre is required in the panchayat.
7. Check dams are required at W.No. 05 + W.No. 06 of the panchayat.
8. One Sewing Centre is needed in the panchayat.
9. Repair of Nallah from the house of Sh. Gulzar Singh upto the house of Sh. Malbinder Singh which requires a grant of 10 lacs.

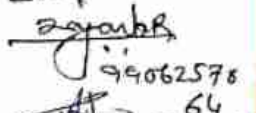
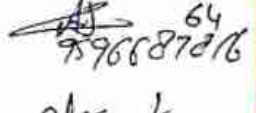
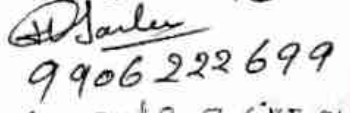
1. The panchayat needs a children play ground and village library to streamline the energy of youth in right direction.
2. Some attention is required for females of the panchayat. Women Self Help groups can be created and activated. Some centres like cutting and tailoring, can be the option for women in the panchayat. This point was also raised in the meeting of women during the visit.
3. The general public has very minor issues like frequent electricity cuts, leakage of underground water pipes laid out by Jal Shakti Deptt. These issues can be resolved by minor planning in the power cuts and plugging of under ground pipes properly.
4. The students enrollment in the only ^{Govt.} primary school in the panchayat is very low i.e 10. Special attention is required towards it so that the school may continue to function in the coming years.
5. From the Agriculture point of view, the millets can be the best option in the panchayat.



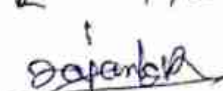
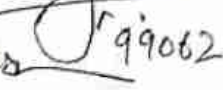
