Overall assessment of the visit

Since the major demand of providing of drinking water which has already been raised in every B2V programmes has been considered under JYM Scheme. The work under the scheme is under process. The people are thankful to the Government for sanctioning of JYM water scheme in Khargund village. The water supply under the scheme to Khargund is expected to be started in the earliest possible time as was informed by the Jal Shakti officer.

One of the complaint in this regard was deraping of road sides due to laying of water pipes which was also brought before the notice of the officers of JS department.

Construction of Panchayat-e-har was also a major demand since longtime raised in every B2V programmes and demand has finally been considered with the start of construction work of Panchayat e-har building. The undersigned also inaugurated the construction work and the building is expected to be completed at an earliest possible time by the Department.

Anganwari centres, Health centre, FPS store, Khidmat centre are running successfully. The staff available in these institutions is punctual, attentive and cooperative. Patwar Khanna is situated in Chowgam village and the concerned Patwar is working responsibly as no complaint against Revenue Department has been received till date. J&K Bank Branch is also available in nearer village of Chowgam. There will be approximately 1100 accounts of Khargund village

in the said bank. More transformers have been installed in the village during last one year. OAP, widow pension figures as reflected in the report as compared to B2V4 report, the reason of the same is exclusion of APL category and online data updation.

Golden Health Card targets are nearly complete. Door to Door survey has also been conducted.

The Department of RDD has taken various plans under Solid Liquid waste management, PMAY house construction for the financial year are complete. Soak pit/Composit pit targets are also complete however some of the households are in pipeline. For proper implementation of SBM-e, Separation Shad has been constructed and needs Rooftop Composit, Safai Karamchori has been hired by the Department and has started performing his job work.

The demand of cutting of some Walnut trees in GMS Khargund was reflected by the School with the Naib Tehsildar concerned during last year, however during B2V5 programme RT and Patwarri concerned has assured needful action at their end.
