Summary note of overall Assessment of the unit and
Suggestions Thereof

Situated in lap of mountains and blessed with numerous springs Malungam D panchayat seem to be a well developed panchayat with macadamised roads however on close look panchayat is suffering from plethora of problems viz

- 1) Lack of drinking water / Tap water absence
- 2) Highly irregular irrigation for fields.
- 3) Education; schools having unsafe buildings, no playground
- 4) Rented buildings for health and veterinary care which are in worst possible condition.
- 5) Lack of panchayat house.

Following are solutions/suggestions to resolve above issues.

1) Lack of drinking water / Tap water

Regeneration of springs → providing reservoir to each spring → which can supply nearly 70% of panchayat. Remaining 30% can be covered by borewells especially in Tikri mohalla.

Permanent solution :- Construction of a large tank with supply from higher canals such as from Athwatoo as per technical feasibility.

2) Education

Govt middle school doesn't have functional Toilets and lack playing ground.

Borewell or connectivity from near spring can be done.

Playing ground :- Total land as per records of revenue is 6kanal and 18 Marlas however presently only 10 marlas are within fencing of school.

Anti Encroachment drive may be started.

Unsafe school building :- repair and renovation or if funds allow dismantling of schools should be done and new with modern design building should be constructed.

3) Sanitation :- dredging and rejuvenation of Dahgam kul should be done on priority basis with start of anti encroachment drive if necessary.

4) Rented building for health and sheep centre
Land should be identified at appropriate places and such centres should be established with sheep centre forcibly in Tikri Mohalle which has a high tribal population.

5) Establishment of Anganwadi centres for each ward or at least supplement no. of anganwadi centres by two.

6) Lack of Panchayat house :- Panchayat house should be constructed at approp. place so that records of local govt can be placed safely and local governance can be strengthened.

I as a visiting officer urge govt to take the above mentioned points on priority basis so that we can make local governance very effective.

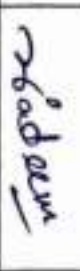
I would also like to bring to your noble attention the pressing need of staff at least 03 more, benches for students, tile flooring inside the school premises and other essential facilities in our school.
