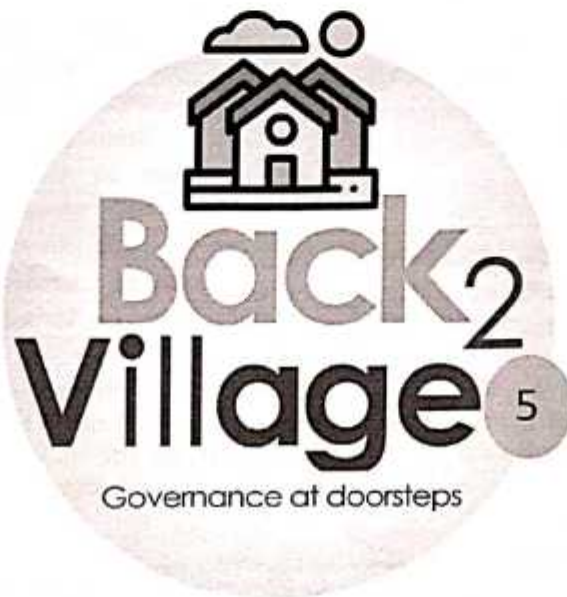

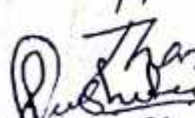
Subject - Request for Major Repair of class rooms.
