The undersigned visited The Panchayat again on que 10th Nov, under B2V5 and visited few sites and made following observations:

- a) The work of borewell digging, initialed after B2V4 has been completed, potable drinking water in enfficient quantity found. However, due to lack of coordination between departments, there is unreceised delay in laying of pipelines, due to which water is getting wasted and people are devoid of water.
- b) dong pending demand of Panchayal Ghar and ATM facility is still unceed wed.
- c) Electric poles are required, since existing ones are in dilapidated condition
- 1) Transport facility requires improvement since only
- e) Bathing ghat required at cremation ground.

 f) No provision of waste/garbage collection from the houses of locals.
- house's of locals g) Lack of awareness of good. schemes amongst locals due to indifference of policies.
- h) Removing encevachments from water bodies and there demands need to be resolved in the first instance to ensure development of the Panchayat. Spoksh Kuran 1/1/1/23
