The Lock to village programme (B2V5) was conducted at CFC building Haedur-Suresh from 9th of November to 10th of November 2023. The participants included the employees and officials of all the frontline departments and the local public. The program was presided over by the visiting officer in the presence of the local panchayat body headed by the Sarpanch.

The program was conducted in a calm & quiet manner and people of the halqa panchayat presented three demands & grievances to the officers of the frontline departments. Many issues were raised regarding the development of the village, some of them are enlisted hereunder.

1. People complained about the lack of adequate drinking water which must be addressed immediately.
2. Fencing of govt primary school Haedur-Suresh.
3. Construction of kitchen at Govt High School HD Suresh and cutting of trees around the school compound which present a great threat to the school building and safety of the students.
4. Upgradation of roads leading to Ichema, Bun Sharan, Panziyai and Saidwan.
5. Providing LPG supply to Anganwadi centers.

These demands were received from the local panchayat body and during the field visit of the institutions.
