Overall assessment of the VSH

The Panchayat Halga Hengipora Block Village is located along Naluk Sandan (i. Hengipora) and on hills (Pethallen and Sastkhuden). The population of the halga is bpl except DDC members family and lack basic facilities of life viz transport health facilities, electricity in semi party.

The people have to face harsh winters due to tremendous snowfall and also firewood is not provided by the concerned department at an ease. The Panchayat has a lot of potential for tourism.

Suggestions

It is suggested that a policy should be framed by the Govt for provision of firewood to these tribal people. The work

on already approved link road from Hengipora to Sastkhuden Nongam road shall be commenced at an earliest.

The under progress Liftway Water Supply scheme ~~shall~~ ^{may} be completed on fast track basis. About 20 electric

Poles and one Hengipora (63KV) may be sanctioned.

Additional soakage pits and Compost pits shall be allocated for the halga so that the

theme "Clean and Green Village" may be achieved. A request that at least tribal level officers / officials shall be deployed for back to village programs.
