Major/urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- The issue of scarcity of water resources (Public water distribution wells, points, ponds, handpumps, borewell) has been repeatedly raised by the residents of the Panchayat but only little has been done so far. As claimed by residents, approximately 30% of the Panchayat still has no access to public water supply. Although some efforts have been made by the Department including drilling of one Borewell at Dral, they are far from complete and require urgent intervention from the concerned Dept.
- Urgent need of Mobile tower for serving the residents of W.no. 5 and 7 including Primary school at Chander.

OVERALL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISIT AND SUGGESTIONS: The Govt. functioning in this Panchayat is commendable on many aspects such as presence of sufficient schools, animal husbandry & sheep husbandry centres, 4 Anganwadi centres, 2 PDS ration stores etc. with dedicated employee. I would like to put the sincerity of most Govt. officials on record as per feedback received from the residents of the Panchayat. But there are some serious issues and following suggestions are hereby submitted to resolve them:

Water scarcity

- 1) The Borewell near Health Centre, Blode has not been commissioned so far even after completion of drilling work and availability of submersible water pump. The pending work includes, installation of submersible pump, installation of starter unit and relevant plumbing work. The only Health centre in the entire Panchayat has no water supply so far and water supply from this bore well should be established to the health centre building.
- 2) Although, two water storage tanks were constructed and pipeline connectivity was established from Tubewell at Kathera to Bhed-Blode Panchayat, water connection work to individual households is still pending. Concerned Dept. should expedite the work. Further, the many of the already established water pipelines connections are either damaged or blocked particularly in Dral. **Water connectivity by the way of drilling of borewell or pipeline connectivity from nearby tube well is urgently required at Govt. Upper Primary School, Patoli.** PHE Dept. seriously needs to take corrective measures in this regard.

Problems faced by Govt. Schools of Panchayat Bhed-Blode

Govt. High School, Blode urgently requires road connectivity from Bus Stop, Blode to its premises. The existing unpaved road is prone to flooding during rainy seasons and seriously affects the functioning of the school. Construction of drain along the boundary wall is required to deal with the flooding inside the school during Monsoon. **Govt. Middle School, Panjiari** is in need of good earth work to develop a playground in its premises. As pre-nursery classes are also going on in the school, rocky ground poses risk of injury to the pupils. The existing washroom lacks water connectivity which defeats the very purpose of having good sanitation facilities. The existing hand pump bore within the school needs to be augmented with submersible pump and water connection needs to be provided to the school building. **Govt. Upper Primary School, Patoli** also lacks public water supply, thus leading to unavailability of potable water and rendering the existing washroom non-functional. Either a dedicated borewell or water connectivity from other sources should be established. **Govt. Primary School, Chander** requires urgent repair and renovation work in its entire building along with construction of 1 additional classroom and the boundary wall. No source of potable water available to this school. Nearby well is not clean and water is not fit for drinking. Moreover, it dries up in the summer further worsening the situation. The connecting path from the main road is susceptible to damage during heavy rains therefore needs protection.

Stalled work of construction of road from Bus stand, Blode to Chander

Although work was tendered and allotted to the contractor, the work has been stalled due to some land dispute and compensation issues. Concerned Dept. should intervene at the earliest as this is a major link road of the Panchayat.

Initiation of Internet services at Panchayat Ghar

Even though necessary infrastructure for providing OFC based internet is in place at Panchayat Ghar, the service has not been started till date. Due to lack of CSC in this Panchayat and overall poor mobile internet connectivity in the Panchayat, internet service availability at Panchayat Ghar becomes absolutely necessary.

Mineral of 2nd installment of PMAY

Non completion of lanes in W.no.1

One of the major lane work in the Panchayat is halted due to shortage of funds. Although the same shall be projected in GPDP plan 2023-24, but any contingency grant for the progress of said work would bring great relief to the residents.

Repair of damaged slab of PMGSY road at Pyt. Bhed Blode

Due to recent floods, a major chunk of a slab of PMGSY road has been damaged and would not survive next Monsoon season. As this the major connecting link between Bhed Blode and Kathua, this needs to be addressed on an urgent basis.
