But as a visiting Officer, I got the opportunity to know the people and the area very closely. The panchayat consists of two Revenue villages lariyar and badipora. Badipora is at least two Kms away from Lariyar which to my understanding has widened the lack of Coordination among the people in participation of plans and programmes. The Panchayat is located on the banks of Watal Ara which has become garbage centre to the People. The infrastructure of govt buildings is very poor, be it UPS. Ayush building. There is no Panchayat Garh despite implementation of Panchayat Raj Act and works are executed under Panchayat Plan. There is least involvement of people in these programmes and people are lacking knowledge about the schemes of Government. The Departments providing beneficial schemes need to reach out to the people.
