- 3). I personally visited the Panchayat Halqa Treran alongwith Sarpanch/ Panchs, BDO and interacted with the frontline workers as well as public. By and large, the public is fairly satisfied with the development in the Halqa which is also visible in terms of the indicators of the development that are significantly higher in most of the government schemes/initiatives. However, there are still some areas of concern and accordingly the demands were raised during my visit which are given below:
 - Lack of proper coordination between I & FC and PHE department.
 - Non-availability of water reservoir for effective utilization of water resources.
 - Absence of Patwarkhana/ Animal & Sheep Husbandry Centres.
 - Lack of proper playground facility even though land is available.
 - Absence of middle school/ lack of infrastructure in existing school especially separate toilet facilities for boys & girls.
 - Absence of aadhaar facilitation centre within the halqa.
 - Excessive documentation demanded by the banks.

Suggestions: -

All the above highlighted demands need immediate remedial measures and the following suggestions may be implemented: -

- Safety audit & inspection of all Halga roads.
- Effective steps for market-linkage of the produce of SHGs/ Income Generating Units.
- More awareness programmes/ sports events need to be organized by Youth Services & Sports Department to engage the youth.
- Effective steps for 100 percent saturation of aadhaar seeding in all government initiatives.
- Availability of Patwari in the Halqa for at least 3 days per week.
- Macadamisation of leftover roads in the halqa.
- Availability of public transport.
- Water treatment plant and testing facility.
