

Moreover, during the visit to the M/S Panekhi it was noticed that the high power electric cables over the path leading to the school are passing very low level thereby endangering the lives of the students and the staff members and secondly the power transform has also been installed at the side of the path which is again a high risk to the person by. So for safety of all the concerned department may kindly be requested to look into the matter and take necessary action for the redressal of the problem.
