Overall Assessment of the Visit and Suggestions

As per Govt directions panchayat halqa Panchpora was visited on 13-11-2023 and 14-11-2023 during B2V5 programme. During this visit functioning of different govt departments was inspected on ground. Frontline workers of different departments briefed about different schemes of their respective departments. Impact of different schemes both UT level and CSS was analysed by interacting with beneficiaries and officials.

Various Govt offices, AWCs, Schools, PDS shops, private shops, Amritsevars and other works were visited and inspected. Interaction with people, school children, teachers, elders, women, shopkeepers, unemployed youth, Self Help group, artisans and their grievances were recorded.

Cultural event, sports event, swachta drive and plantation drive were held during the programme. Awareness about Jan Bhagyadari and BEAMS was given during this function. Khidmat centre (CSC) is fully functional in the panchayat.

Various departments gave awareness about different schemes to people and ensured targets are achieved in shortest possible time. PMAY houses were inspected and families living there are fully satisfied.

Plain areas of Panchayat are fully connected and have good condition of roads but Check-Dadoo roads need more attention/repair. Cleanliness in the panchayat is satisfactory but sanitation workers of panchayat must be paid regularly. In some areas of panchayat electric wires are supported by plants and trees.

Although all departments are working hard for the benefit of people of Panchpora PH but people are satisfied with the work of RDD, ICDS, Health and Education departments. People are having bitter experience of PDD due to frequent unscheduled prolonged power cuts and inflated bills.

Unemployed youth of PH are particularly unhappy with the functioning of Govt.

Govt. land is available for social forestry, tourism and industrialisation in the panchayat.

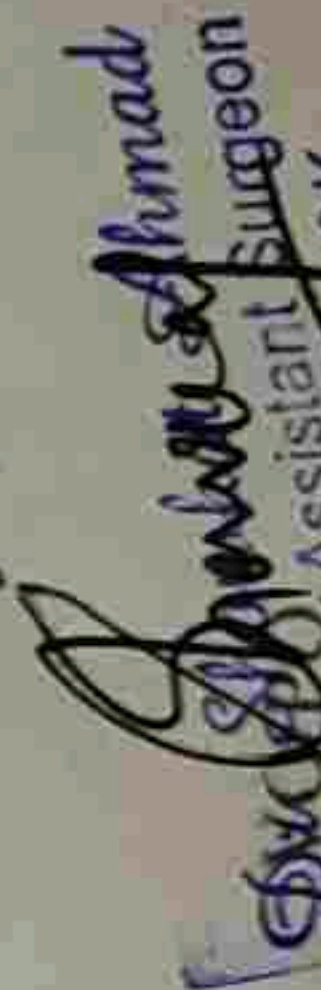
People lauded the efforts of Govt. for NashaMuktabhiyan and corruption free society.

Playground needs repair and upgradation.

As village Marhama is revenue village of P.H Panchpora and other villages. People demanded Panchpora be made separate revenue village.

As there is no bank branch in the P.H, people demanded ATM facility in the P.H.

Children park may be made near Govt M/s Checke Panchpora to make village child friendly.

Children suffer due to lack of Anganwari centre in Checke Dadoo (Nasir Mohalla), so AWC be sanctioned.

Govt. building for Health and Wellness centre Panchpora as people and staff suffer due to rented accommodation.

Acute shortage of staff at Govt. M/s Check Panchpora. Need more teachers to deliver good services.

Upgradation of Govt M/s Check Panchpora to High school.

Poor condition of Road from Check to Check Dadoo. Road is around 2km and needs macadamisation and drainage.

Sports stadium (playground) at P.H Panchpora is in poor condition and needs rapid development and upgradation.

Requirement of road from Grid Station Playfield Panchpora (Nambal Nallah) to K. Koot. Because people suffer due to excessive water in Nambal Nallah.

Electric wire is supported by plants at Nasir Mohalla - Dadoo Post. Threat to general public. Need of electric poles (15 No.) and wire ACSR = 0.5 around 2km length.
