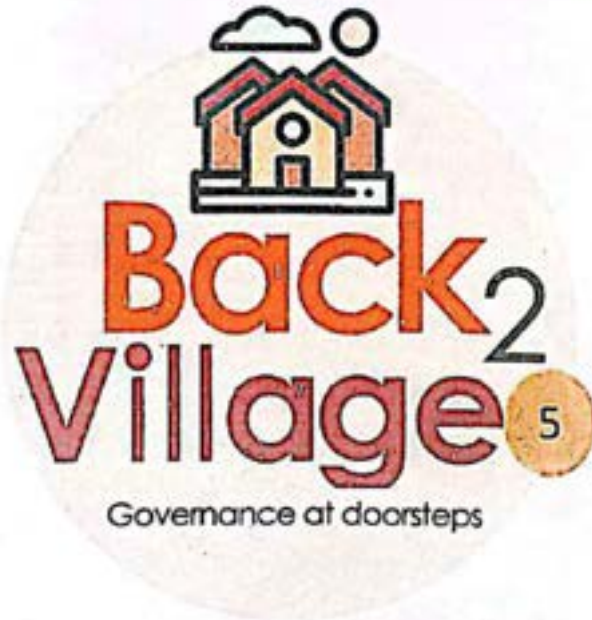

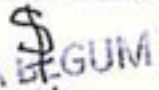

Major Complaints

01. Water tank has been constructed by PHE department & pipes not laid since long. The desired no. of pipes should have been provided by the department to benefit the locals.
02. Kandi-Jamia Masjid road is being constructed by PW(R&B) department under CRF. The progress is good but currently the work is at halt as forest department has not provided the NOC for moving the alignment through the forest, despite the documents being uploaded on Parivesh portal.
03. The electric poles have not been provided in sufficient number and reportedly the wires are hanging at some places on the branches of tree.
04. A transformer has been installed by the power department near Panchayat Bazar but is not in use since long.
05. The water distribution pipes at many locations have deteriorated and need to be replaced.
06. Old building of Boys Middle School Kandi has been dismantled but the new building has yet not been constructed. The classes are being arranged & in the ground outside & if there is a rain/snow, the classwork gets disturbed badly.

Major/urgent Public Demands

01. There is an urgent need of building for Boys middle school Kandri as the students are suffering badly.
02. There is an urgent need for repair & renovation of the Health and wellness center (NTPHC) at Kandri.
03. The Health center should be provided with the sufficient medical and paramedical staff so that the people don't suffer & hence get a first hand treatment in the panchayat.
04. An additional transformer is demanded by the residents of the panchayat.
05. Razwar Kol has partially been constructed in the panchayat and hence needs to be completed so that the habitants adjacent to the Kol don't get affected by the leakages & overflows. The command area of the kol will also get enhanced by preventing the leakages.
