- The undersigned is witnessed of the three beautifully constructed buildings belongs to tourism deptt. which are locked and not utilized for the purpose.
 - Urgent & foremost need for establishment of Primary health centre at that first aid and the basic treatment can be given to the patients.
 - It is also requisite to educate the unemployed and educated youth about the scope of self employment generation schemes and motivate them to avail the benefits of the schemes.
 - There is not active involvement of pvt. body and there is gap between the general public & pvt. body which need to be bridged.
 - Apart from above, the Govt. Middle School situated at Ker, needs to be upgraded for better education.
- Though the Village Panchayat Dhamla Mahapur is located in the hilly area and has the tremendous potential to attract the tourists, yet the Panchayat has not developed so far.
