ANNEXURE I

(1 of 2)

In recent years since the Inception of B2V1, a lot of development has taken place. The masses of the village are content & Satisfied in relation to many developments which have taken so far. Some major developments pertain to the Installation of Transformers in Khadernov. Also the demand for construction of 12ft. road along north side of Nalab Turban has been met. Establishment of dept. of sheep husbandary is also a good step in this regard. Cross Drain Manual has also been established which comes as a great relief to the people of the area.

Moving towards some specific observations as far as Education sector is concerned, especially teachers are doing a commendable job in terms of overall development of the children. Yet again a lot more needs to be done especially in terms of infra-structure. Mostly in all schools multiple classes operate in a single room. Recently some buildings of some schools were declared unsafe but the ~~same~~ ^{issue} was taken up by the concerned Panchayat & some steps are already taken in this behalf. Some other imp. issues which need to be addressed are: ① Availability of Pink Toilets ② Computer lab.

③ As far as roads are concerned, a lot of work has been done by the RDO dept & I received praises from the society. Cond. of roads has improved since B2V1 but still some areas are still left, especially the ^{link} road leading to the GMS (govt middle school, Grits) is in a pitiable condition with deep potholes filled with water it makes it impossible to walk on this stretch. One major demand by public is Macadamization of roads.

(II) Healthcare system:- Health & wellness centers ⁽²⁹²⁾ are available at Marwal & Khadeemov. Availability of medicines is also ensured & proper Immunization & other related facilities are also provided. Water & Electric supply has also improved since last year.
Suggestions :- 1. Establishment of PNH toilet ② Availability of more staff.
3. Availability of sweeping staff.

④ Bank Etc :- One major absence in the area is the non-availability of Bank branch & ATM. As such the residents face a lot of hardships in daily routine. This is a prime issue which needs redressal.

⑤ A major achievement in the area is regarding solid & liquid waste management. Many Compost pits, Soakage pits & segregation sheds are constructed, but more awareness about their use in public should be made so that they become fully functional.

⑥ Transport facility has also improved, yet in some areas it is not sufficiently catering the needs of the people. There is an urgent demand of public transport facility from Pulewara via Marwal to Rampore.

⑦ Proper domestic waste disposal is an area where more steps need to be taken. Door to door collection of domestic waste is absent in some areas.

⑧ As far as anganwadi centers are concerned, no major complaint was brought forth. Availability of supplementary meals etc was also assured & there has been a great improvement in this regard since BQV4.

⑨ Uninterrupted & smooth availability of Ration should be assured after proper verification for categorization as APL, BPL etc.

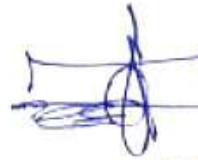
