Basic living conditions was availability of food(Rice), drinking water conditions, water supply, electricity, roads and sanitation were reviewed.

Grievances have been scripted on paper most of them have not been addressed fully so far. People being disappointed by almost defunct grievances redressal mechanism.

It becomes clear from the aforementioned facts that the implementation of the last four phases of the back to village programme a "Potential path breaker on the paper faced a lot of challenges on the ground. However the administration has one more chance in the form of the 5th phase(B2V-5) to ensure the effective implementation of the programme

3. Construction, voiding and macadamization main road to wassanmarg from check post to wassanmarg have been raised during B2V1, B2V2, B2V3 and B2V4 but not addressed till date. Public is suffering.
4. Problem regarding drinking water supply as volume of water is not sufficient for the inhabitants.
5. It has come to the notice that it becomes very costly to irrigate and supriy the horticulture fields and loss of huge money because unavailability of irrigation water as there is a need to construction the towels.
6. The area is for flung / remote the inhabitants (wassanmarg)are being treated as animals with out basic amenities the public says.
7. During winter months the inhabitants of wassanmar claim that they are suffering from shortage of drinking water and power supply .
