During my visit at Village Panchayat Lamsora at B2V5 as visiting officer, I observed that the PRI members & the people are aware of Centrally Sponsored Scheme's. All PRI members and public took the Pledge on Nashamukt Bharat & Corruption free governance, They are well aware on digital services. It was also observed that the work projected in B2V1, B2V2 & B2V3 & B2V4 need to be solved, Hence some works were completed.

It was observed that the demand of public for Upgradation of M/S Sarangdhar, Kabbi & Pathoin Kabbi to high school need to be redressed & Moreover the toilets are non functional at M/S Kabbi and also there is one cracked building at M/S Kabbi should need repair immediately.

It was also demanded by the PRI members & general public of W NO 5, 6, 7 that their PHE pipes are broken & need repair immediately & Construction of Road from Kote gali to Sugandhar 8km should be done on priority basis.

All the govt. employee working in pvt Lamsora are working with liason with PRI members, but the Land bar books are not prepared till date by the revenue department. I need to prepare as soon as possible.

I am lucky enough to visit the village pvt Lamsora in B2V5 program, interacted with PRI members, general public, govt officials, senior citizen's, dadies & children & instructed them all to work jointly for the upgradation of pvt Lamsora.
