1. The Panchayat halqa is under development.
2. Different works demanded during BSV, BSV, BSV and BSV programs are still untouched.
3. Different Schemes launched by the Govt. through various departments, especially the line departments are missing at the ground level this is due to the fact that people are unaware about most of the schemes.
4. All the departments working on the frontline in the Panchayat halqa should keep cooperation and should formulate a joint developmental plan for the Panchayat.
5. More employment opportunities should be created through Panchayats.
6. Most of roads in the Panchayat halqa are without blacktops and needs improvement.
7. The newly constructed hospital building ~~is still~~ is still incomplete and needs special attention of the administration.
8. PHE department is working good in the Panchayat but there are many gaps which needs immediate attention.
9. RDD department is playing a vital role in the development of the Panchayat halqa. They need to improve their performance, further.
10. Further, the district administration can play a key role in the development of the Panchayat by organising different awareness programmes with the involvement of all frontline departments.
