Annexure-A

During the visit in B2V5 programme of the visiting officer Dr. Anil Saloch, District TB Officer, Udhampur in presence of Sarpanch Hartaryan on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> November 2023 in Panchayat Hartaryan block Udhampur.

The following observations have been made as under: -

1. The various Developmental works has been executed and some are under progress depending upon the availability of funds.
2. The various departmental schemes had been shared with the public by the concerned departments from time to time.
3. The satisfactory co-ordination between the Sarpanch & other PRIs members with different departments in the Pyt regarding the development of the area.

However, it has been further observed that said Panchayat is geographically widely spread and needs: -

1. Improvement in various roads connectivity within Panchayat and with the other Panchayats.
2. Provision of Ration Depo./ Extension counter.
3. Provision of CSC (Common Service Centre).
4. Community Hall.
5. Play Ground.
6. Adequate availability of employees against the posts lying vacant in various departments particularly in Govt. High School Upper Hartaryan which has been upgraded to High School few years back but with same staff structure of Middle School level.

The various demands projected by the PRIs and General public are as under: -

1. T-road from Saniote to Kasha nehar and Pyt Hartaryan
2. T-road from Kasha nehar to Baggad Pyt Hartaryan
3. Boundary wall at MS Saniote Zone Tikri and
4. Boundary wall at MS Orah Zone Tikri
5. Repair of building Govt. Primary School Ora Bagal needs repair.
6. Public Toilet at W. No. 1 Panchayat Hartaryan.
7. Road connectivity Deil to Vakal.
8. Construction of Passenger Shed at W. No. 1.
9. Repair of Irrigation Khul Sunadi to Vakal (3 to 4 Kms).
10. Foot Bridge over Nardan Nallah W. No. 5 Pyt Hartaryan.
11. Foot Bridge over Chobber Nallah W. No. 6 Pyt Hartaryan.
12. Overall road repair Palli to Upper Hartaryan.
13. Provision of Electric Poles (100 Nos. in Pyt. Hartaryan)
14. Improvement of Animal Husbandry Centre Upper Hartaryan.
15. Handover takeover of Sheep Ext. Centre at Upper Hartaryan.



DEMANDS RELATING TO PYT HARTARYAN FOR B2-V5

1. Back to village programme. Nearly 100% demands submitted during B2-VI to B2-V4 remained un-solved in respect of each HOD despite of letter issued by DDC Udhampur. Intermediary reply was not provided by any HOD as yet.
2. Disposal of grievances reported in complaint box in pyt char. Number of grievances were reported but not even a single matter is intimated as solved to the applicant.
3. Disposal of complaints reported on Wednesday in DDC office. No complaint is solved as yet.
4. Establishment of Distt: Grievance cell. Not yet established as per Govt order No 1361-GAD of 2018.
5. Shortage of field staff. There was net shortage of 2203 staff in 11 offices/department as on 31-7-2021 for which no action is taken at any level.
6. Stay of field staff in rural areas. In the past, 100% staff was staying in their own duty place like Patwari, forest guard, VLWS and teachers but at present all are staying outside duty station except local staff. Patwari Halqa is controlling 5 to 6 villages whereas no Patwar Khanna is approved by the department despite DPR prepared in the past by PWD. No action is taken to obtain revised DPR by the Revenue department.
7. Functioning of our Panchayat. Our panchayat is looking after block agency and no resolution of other departments is framed on required basis. For instance, no resolution is framed relating to PWD road. Our Panchayat itself is not yet obtained water connection & electricity officially.
8. KVK - Except Udhampur district, all other district are having KVK. All connected documents for the same are kept pending in DC office. This is the main requirement of all Panchayats.
9. Establishment of medicinal nursery. There is no medicinal nursery in District Udhampur. Our request stands sent to the Assistant District Medical Officer (ISM) Udhampur under Adal DDC Udhampur. NO ADDCU/Rep/2021-22/2151-53 of 1-9-2021 but no action as yet.
10. Staff for Govt HS Upper Hartaryan. This school was upgraded during 2014 but the staff as was provided for middle school is still working without mastergrade teacher. Only 6 teachers are working and 4 teachers have not been attached upto 31 Mar 2024. No action was taken by the CEO as no mastergrade staff is provided to this school.
11. Non-teaching duties in Govt schools. Teachers are regularly being detailed
  - (a) on non-teaching duties like election, census, survey, midday meals etc.
  - (b) Govt PS Telta sonari was <sup>opened</sup> during 2014 but no Govt accommodation is provided.
  - (c) Failure candidates in 10 & 12th class. Readmission in same class is to be allowed till they qualify their examination.
  - (d) Co. education. To be reviewed as it did not bring better result.



12. Medical department.

(a) Govt building as under still to be provided:-

- (i) Govt PHC Hartaryan as per PWD pattern covering labour room.
- (ii) Govt sub centre Upper Hartaryan - As per PWD pattern.
- (b) Upgradation of Govt Medical sub centre Upper Hartaryan upto doctor (MBBS) level which will also cover adjoining areas.

13. Agriculture

- (a) Special repair to seed centre Sonari. DPR for Rs 4 lacs was sent to Director Agri office Jammu which remained un-attended. Now revised DPR is needed for which no action is taken as yet.
- (b) New Seed Centre in Upper Hartaryan.

14. PWD roads:

- (a) Pali to Upper Hartaryan road. work started during 2006-07 but still not completed. There is worst condition of road from Sonari to Upper Hartaryan.
- (b) New link road from Kared to the house of Munshi Ram which was recommended by the chairman DDC Udhampur but not yet started though NOC was provided by the block agency as 50% earth work was done by the block agency.

15. PMGSY roads:

- (a) New road from Senot to Kund Upper Hartaryan via Jamwal/Pagwal. Already included in Back to village programme B-2V4.
- (b) Road from Thati to Salada/Kalka Mandir Badshan.
  - (a) Pucca lane protection not done.
  - (b) A portion about 50 metres damaged after 2 km.
  - (c) Upgradation of road from Pali to Upper Hartaryan as the same not yet made functional for the last so many years.
  - (d) New road from Pyt Ghar Upper Hartaryan to Kalso ward. (Earth work already done by block).

16. Sports. Play ground stands approved long back but land not yet identified by the Revenue (abnormally delayed).

17. Block agency

- (a) Peace committee. A proposal for peace committee without financial effect stands submitted to AC Dev. Udhampur in lieu of Pyt Adalat which remained un-attended.
- (b) Revision of rates of skilled & un-skilled labour.
- (c) Non-function of Pyt complaint box.
- (d) proper maintenance of Pyt record despite of our requests.

18. Mobile problems

signal problems of Airtel and BSNL. Despite of letters from chairman DDC Udhampur/DDC Udhampur/Addl DDC Udhampur, no action is taken to attend the problem.

19. Irrigation.

- (a) Only one Kul is under construction in Upper Hartaryan for the last so many years and work done is not yet inspected by any senior officer despite of our request. Last portion remained un-attended.
- (b) Work on Kared (sonari) kul not yet started.
- (c) No protection work alongside Nullah in Upper Hartaryan is done.
- (d) FI information as requested not yet provided.
- (e) There are 2 more Kul in Upper Hartaryan as per B2-V4.

20. Food and supply. Existing sale centre in Upper Hartaryan to be converted to Govt ration ~~and~~ stores so that adjoining areas are also covered.

21. JJM (P/E)

- (a) WSS Kambal Danga upto Gopalpur (lift scheme)
- (b) New scheme at Kalka mandir (Badshan) Upper Hartaryan  
Only nominal work is being executed and expected period of completion of above scheme is not known to all.
- (c) Filtration plants  
(i) Kared sonari - *Non-* functional.  
(ii) Jamwal mohalla Only non-drinkable water is being provided.  
(iii) Jamwal scheme is to be upgraded and old pipes are to be replaced.
- (d) No of houses likely to be covered in Upper Hartaryan from Kalka Mandir source is not yet made known despite of our request.
- (e) Non-regular staff is not yet upgraded as regular staff.
- (f) Shortage of field staff.

22. Forest

- ( ) Demarcation of forest remained un-attended.
- (b) Encroachment of forest land - NO action at forest level.
- (c) Medicinal plant nursery to be established. Free irrigated land will be provided if needed.
- (d) ~~stay~~ of field staff at duty station.

23. social forestry department

- (a) Improvement of closures. No action is taken to replace damaged fencing since long.
- (b) New closure is needed at sonari proper alongside road.
- (c) Shortage of staff- No action is taken in this regard as matter is to be taken up with higher authorities to do the needful.

24. JK Wild life wing. As other forest offices are not very keen towards improvement of forest, A J&K wildlife wing is to be created in our area.



26. Transport

- (a) Bus stand Udhampur. Both ARTO & Branch Manager fully failed to provide regular bus service despite of our repeated requests to ARTO. ARTO also failed to provide reply of our requests for the information of all concerned.
- (b) Mini-bus operators at Udhampur. Neither ARTO nor concerned Manager are in a position to solve our genuine requests. Mobile & tape record are being used which *L. un-checked*. Regular mini-buses are not ensured. When a mini-bus is on tour, no alternative arrangement is made. All timings are also not covered by some Mini-buses but no action is taken on our request.

27. Corruption. As reported by SVC, Works, Revenue, Police, Health and Power, Rural development, social welfare, forest, CAMPD & education are most corrupt departments. This issue is still be handled on top priority to save income of rural public.

28. Grievances. At HODs level, no keen interest is shown by any HOD despite letters from higher offices. *When* higher offices are kept informed in some cases, applicants are *not* informed, where informed as per their letters, copies are not sent to the concerned *applicant*.

29. Postal. BO Hartaryan is located in village sonari when it was a centre place for four villages namely Hartaryan, Sonari, Kambal Danga & Mongerly. Now all four places are separate villages and as such Hartaryan BO is to be located at centre place of Hartaryan near Panchayat Ghar in ward Jamwal. For other three villages, new BO be provided if demanded by them. Therefore, shifting of existing BO from village sonari to Hartaryan is not to be delayed on any ground. At present, department also failed to provide letter box at centre place of Hartaryan. Letter box are also to be provided in village Mongerly, Kambal Danga & Sonari (after shifting of BO)

30. Banking/Khadmet centre. Nor any bank branch is opened as per our request and approval in DDC meeting nor any khadmet centre is provided despite our request to LDM, SBI Udhampur.

31. Watershed under DWP. Since forest departments did not improve our area as needed, a watershed programme is the main requirement so that development of our village is not delayed further.

32. Municipal council Udhampur.

- (a) Like Katra, Udhampur is to be accorded same treatment based on Devika sanctity. There should not be any meat and fish sale or wine shop within 1 KM, if not more, from the holy devika.
- (b) Though devika Project now located but cleanliness of water of said place is not fully ensured.
- (c) Encroachment alongside devika is also to be removed.
- (d) Bazar/streets are always covered for parking purposes and shops are extended upto centre moving areas.
- (f) Vehicles are parked on both sides of Bazar/streets.



33. Revenue department

- (a) Pass books not yet issued to village Hartaryan & Sonari as settlement of these villages not yet done.
- (b) Identification of land for construction of sports stadium/plyground for Hartaryan Udhampur as per AC (Rev) Udhampur NO ACRU/SQ/598-603 of 26-5-2022. As per letter from J&K Sports Council, the above work was to be executed during capex budget 2022-23 but it is held up in the office of Teh Udhampur.

- (c) Unauthorised collection of stones/sand from Nallah alongside village Hartaryan as per DC Udhampur NO LA/ADCU/2022-23/908-12 of 23-5-2022 - Letter is made as URGENT but remained un-attended.

- (d) KVK in Udhampur - The required papers were sent to DC Udhampur under Teh: Udhampur NO TUDR/OQ/2020-21/354 of 6-8-2020. Thereafter, no action is taken either by DC Udhampur or Tehsildar Udhampur to ascertain latest position and to inform SKUAST Jammu *on priority*.

(e) Patwar Hartaryan

- (a) Patwar Khanna, DDCUha Udhampur under his NO DDCU/SSC/2021-22/18-9-2021 asked certain information from AC (Rev) Udhampur but the latest position is not known even to patwari Halsa Hartaryan as confirmed by him on 11-11-2023.
- (b) DPR for Rs 4.00 prepared by PWD now required to be revised. Whether department has requested PWD to do the needful is not known.
- (c) Encroachment of state/forest land. Only entries stand deleted but no action is taken for removal of encroachment in any case as yet. When asked Teh Udhampur under RTI Act, it was informed that the same is not a part of their office under his NO TUDR/RTI/2023-24/39 of 6-7-2023.
- (d) PMAY cases - Illegal cases are also approved as cited in application dated 21-7-2023 sent to AC (Dev) Udhampur under NO SSC/H/40 of 23 Jul 2023 but no action at BDO's level. Most of the cases, houses are being constructed at other places instead of doing it on the same kh. No which was cited in the revenue record. In one case, there was applicant from Pyt Hartaryan whereas he constructed house in Pyt Sonari and that too on state land.
- (e) Change of father's name. An application sent to NI Tikri by Teh Udhampur on 21-11-2019 remained pending in respect of Sh: Nar Singh.
- (f) Providing revenue documents.

certain documents were requested through online system but only part information is provided. When Teh Udhampur was requested to provide information under RTI Act, it was informed to contact patwari Halsa under his NO TUDR/RTI/2023-24 of 6-7-23. *Who* is always away from the Patwar itself on a number of days.

- (g) Shifting of patwari record. It is being shifted from one place to other from time to time which creates problems for the public in addition to wastage of some record in doing so. The record should always to be kept in the centre place which is Sonari. Therefore Patwar Khanna is very essential which is being delayed.


