During the interaction with the panchayat body, general public, youth, women and other representatives' various suggestions and demands were put forward and discussed. There is a huge scope for tourism development, dairy farming, sheep rearing, poultry farming in the panchayat as the people are already engaged in these activities. Also there is a good number of youth engaged with different trades like mechanics, carpentry. drivers, kangri weavers and other artisans. Introducing them to different self-employment schemes like HADP, PMEGP, MSME, PM Vishwakarma etc will not only help them upgrade their trade but also help boost the economy of the panchayat and provide employment unemployed youth. From Tourism point of view, the panchayat falls on the main road to Sinthan Top Deksum thus providing a huge scope for tourism based schemes like capacity building for service providers, skill development, Hunar se Rozgar tak etc. Development of eco park in the area

		will not only provide a recreational point for the tourists travelling to Sinthan top but will also provide jobs to unemployed youth.
