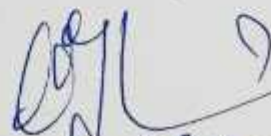
2. Complaint against one RRET Mtr. Gaurnam Kour PLS Khaitan attached PLS Pathana Gulpur (Poonch)
