Most respects and regards, I panch of village Heenwoder on behalf of the villagers of the said village would like to draw your kind attention towards the fact that the school building has got major cracks and is not safe for the teaching learning process. There are only three classrooms for nine classes including 1kg class, so how it is possible to conduct nine classes in only 3 classrooms on daily basis as a result it will adversely effect the teaching learning process of the students. There are 72 students in the school and the teachers conduct the classes in open sky.

We had informed higher ups and back to villagers visiting officers time to time but all in vain as no action has taken in this regard yet.

now, it is therefore requested your good self to kindly issue order for the dismantling of the building and then construction of new 2 storey building, so that the problem will be solved once for all.
