Priority demands of the people of Sheikhpora Panchayat

- ① As in previous B.V's the people of Sheikhpora demand that the bridge connecting Sheikhpora to different areas may be constructed at an earliest. One bridge at Seim which has been left incomplete by R.N.B (75% the work has been done) should be constructed as early as possible as this bridge will connect people of Seim with Kangraon. Similarly a bridge at Sheikhpora is again demand of the people. R.N.B department is again requested to take this issue seriously.
- ② Post office at Sheikhpora and Seim should be opened as the people of these villages suffer a lot.
- ③ Bathrooms and SBM for Sheikhpora and Seim middle schools proposed under B.V's.
- ④ Health sub centre / dispensary proposed for Seim as villagers have to travel a lot on foot if some medical emergency ~~case~~ happens.
Health centre and Panchayat Chair at Sheikhpora have been locked by the owners of the land who donated the land to R.O.D and Health departments should be made functional at an earliest and the dispute between land owner and the concerned departments should be solved.
- ⑤ Children's park at Seim may be developed on modern lines and flower culture / gardening departments should be involved in beautification and maintenance of the park.
- ⑥ Drains / Culverts at different spots at Sheikhpora and Seim are recommended.
Segregation shed at Sheikhpora recommended.
- ⑦ Three Transformers / 20 HT poles may be provided to the inhabitants of Sheikhpora and Seim.
- ⑧ Helpers / workers at different Aanganwadis centres are the demands of the public.
- ⑨ Gupha bell a place in Seim Sheikhpora needs to be developed as tourist spot.
- ⑩ Fencing of different grave yards, ~~other~~ Ziyarats at different spots of Sheikhpora and Seim demands of the public.

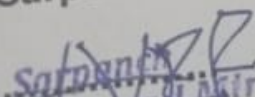
