Concerned authorities shall look into it and make this life line functional as early as possible. - Local population demands electric receiving station in the Panchayat for smooth functioning of water filtration plants and lift irrigation systems located in the GP - The common masses especially elders are facing huge difficulties for withdrawing cash from ATMs as they have to travel long distances for it. So, provision of ATM facilities in the GP will be helpful. - Since, agriculture is backbone for local economy in the GP, renovation of existing lift irrigation systems is direly required. - Augmentation and creation of new electric transformers with LT/HT especially at Barzalli Mohalla - Installation of solar lights at grave yards - New Anganwadi Centres at Iqbal colony and Kawini - Illegal extraction of sediments from Jhelum river damaging its banks which may cause serious issues during floods - Boundary wall/fencing around Govt Primary and Middle Schools Kawini - Heavy trucks plying on main road of GP making the local population prone to accidents and damaging the local road - Water filtration plant at Barzalli Mohalla to be made functional as soon as possible.
