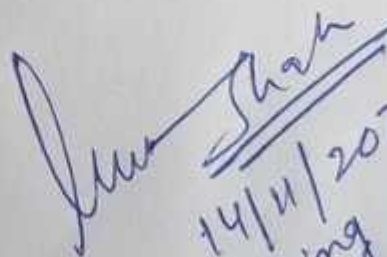

MAJOR DEMANDS AND ASSESSMENT.

- 1). Improvement of electric networking system. Replacement of old L.T lines (wires) by new L.T electric wires and installation of electric poles to village Uttarpora and Rankipora through Chama Mohallah.
- 2). Road connectivity from Uttarpora to Khatema and from Patarkoot to Laxdal. Replacement of Kikee Singh and Saroop Singh road.
- 3). Construction of Bridge/Culvert from Govt. Primary School Chama Mohalla to Sonawalla Nagar.
- 4). Construction, repairment and upgradation of all the link roads of Uttarpora and road from Uttarpora to Rankipora through Chama Mohallah.
- 5). Furniture and Utensils for all the Anganwadi Centers of Uttarpora and Rankipora.
- 6). Fencing of graveyards and street lights for Hafqa Uttarpora.

ASSESSMENT

Keeping in view the topography of the village, meetings held with Panchayat members, visits with local senior citizens and students, the said village is in need of construction of Govt. buildings for middle school Utterpora and PHC Utterpora. Electric networking system with new electric poles should be taken with account. Main road connecting Utterpora and Rankipora and other villages should be repaired. Middle school Utterpora is functioning satisfactorily. However, the Govt. building should be constructed so that no hurdle should come in the way of smooth functioning of the school. Plantation drive should be conducted along the road side from main road to Utterpora for beautification and ecological balance and for stopping landslide. Bio-diversity communities to be formed for conservation of bio-diversity and sustainable utilization of biological resources. Panch. committees to be activated and meetings should be held with Panchayat body. Organisation of atleast one supporting activity and Inlet Saver should be constructed to conserve water bodies. Self-employment drives should be done at Panchayat level.
