

MAJOR DEMANDS/COMPLAINTS OF PRIS LOCALS OF PANCHAYAT KAGHOTE-B:

1. Jal Shakti Deptt.:
 - Problems faced by the people of Lehri that no water connection is still provided to them.
 - The Govt. Middle School has water tank but has no water supply connection. A written complaint regarding the water supply is also received from the Headmaster of GMS.
 - Locals raised complaint that there is no proper digging while laying down pipelines under JJM.
 - Many households from Santhal (around 10 HH) and Lehri area who don't have piped water connection. They demanded piped water connection on priority basis.
 - Locals from Ward Lehri faced the problem of inadequate water supply. Demands raised to maintain regular water supply and also demanded proper laying of pipes under JJM.
2. Demand for CSC Unit at HS Kaghote.
3. Demand for dismantling of defunct building of HS Kaghote. *and MS Lehri.*
4. Demand for water connection at HS Kaghote.
5. Dev Raj S/o Birbal R/o Lehri has demanded that there is one small foot bridge in W.No. 3 for which steps have not been constructed properly due to which neither it is commutable for public as well as for cattles. Demanded for proper construction of steps on one side of said foot bridge.
6. Public of the Panchayat raised the problem of frequent electric cuts. Also, there is no representative from the PDD deptt. present during B2V5.
7. There is no ration depot on the Panchayat in Kaghote-B. Locals used to draw ration from nearby Panchayat Kaghote-A. Locals demanded for an early opening of fair Price Shop in Panchayat Kaghote-B.
8. Residents of Ward No. 7 Santhal demanded a culvert and water supply.
9. Construction road from Kaghote Bridge to Santhal Lehar Mohalla (Bandli) has been sanctioned under NABARD at cost of Rs 1237.30 Lacs. There is demand for start of this project at an earliest.
10. Deputation of cooks working in Schools for Mid Day Meal purpose raised the issue of their salary. They have not received their salaries from last few months and the Central Govt. share amounting to Rs. 100/- per month was also stopped. They also demanded for enhancement in their salary.
11. Titru Ram S/o kultu, Geeta Devi W/o Gopi and many other raised the complaint regarding old age pension that they have not received the old age pension for last 5 months. Representative from Social Welfare Deptt. was directed to do the needful in the matter.
12. Portal of Ayushman Bharat under Health Department is not working due to which public is facing difficulty. Demands to open the portal so that public may get smooth facility for uploading/updating relevant data.
13. Mali cum chowkidar of Panchayat Ghar also raised his voice to provide honorarium from the Govt. share amounting to Rs. 500/- month.
14. Demand of PNC at Kaghote-B is also raised by the locals.
