Major issue of concern in the Panchayat is to initiate the tenders process for new Primary Health Centre (PHC) building as the old building is in critical condition and is declared unsafe.

2. Replacement of existing poles & wires by S.T. Poles & Cables in whole Panchayat.
3. Being a border area, more ^{individual} bunkers are required for public safety.
4. Upgradation/Widening of Link road from vill. ^{Gilard} Pandhri to ^{Pangdohr} Gilard with two lanes specifications (Approx. 3 KM).
5. Playground required at Hn Sec. School, Gilard.
6. Boundary wall required at High School, Gilard.
7. Installation of ATM in Panchayat.
3. Installation of Khidmat Centre.
1. Repair of roads with black-topping in whole Panchayat.
5. Construction of road from Gilard via Cremation ground to Chak Faquir (Approx. 2.5 KM).
