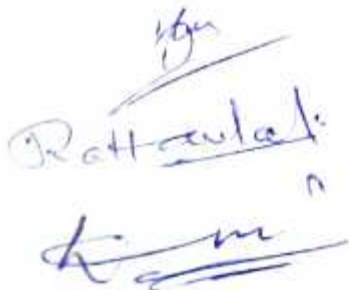
We the inhabitants of panchayat CHACK MALAL are facing so many problems due to various govt department. Which are given as under :-

With humble submission, we the resident of village Chakmalal want to put some demands of our village such as:

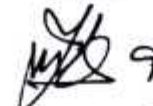
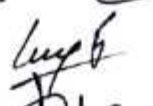
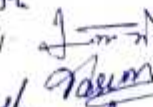
1. Construct the Agriculture road from Jounian union road near army camp to dohal along with malleh
