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#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The visiting officer shall spend at least three days in a Gram Panchayat to assess the details of
- 2. He/She shall refrain from giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.

3. He/She is going to the Panchayat as a planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for

the Gram Panchayat comprehensively.

4. While preparing the Gram Panchayat development plan, he/she has to ensure that demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs, and the rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans.

5. His/her work shall be hard-core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

6. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that at least one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure the conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat-wise orders need to be issued in advance.

7. The BDO has to ensure that Gram Sabha is held during the visit of the officer in the panchayat

and uploaded on Vibrant Gram Sabha Portal.

8. The visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the Panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the Sarpanch and by the visiting officer on the www.jkpanchayat.jk.gov.in portal.

9. The focus of the visit is on youth, skills, self-employment, Nasha Mukt, Bhrashtachar Mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides carrying forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturating

them.

He/she shall ensure that the BDC Chairperson and Sarpanch/Panch are present at the time of inauguration and ceremonies.

10. The visiting officer shall not leave the district without handing over a hard copy of the report to the Rural Development official (BDO/Panchayat Secretary) for further uploading of the report on the www.jkpanchayat.in / www.jkpanchayat.jk.gov.in portal within a week's time, positively.
