Macadamization of inner link roads in GP approximately 3 km is total length which can easily be taken up by R&B department under CNT program 2. Power infra is very weak. Conductors are low and supported by popular uprights. Highly accident Prone The GP Requires at least 30 tubular poles with 3 km of conductor wire to replace old damaged while also load balancing should be done between the transformers and additional 03 Transformers of 100 KV need to be installed. 3. As per the complaint of public and Panchayat body, drinking water being supplied is for a very short duration and doesn't cater to the needs of GP. The timing should be increased and water should be treated before supplying to public. 4. Coming to education. The high school lacks basic facility of water filter to provide safe drinking water to children. The middle school and pry school operating from same premises are in a very dilapidated condition. Washrooms are stinking dilapidated which need immediate attention. 5. Lastly, the hospital building built from KLC funds should be utilized properly as it is highly un-utilised and only one health and Wellness Centre is operating from it. The demand of public is to upgrade the same to PHC. The building also requires roofing with additional work in its second story.
