Further availability of ration at govt outlets at affordable rates has also been appreciated. The initiatives taken under JJM and PMGSY (02 roads executed-01 more sanctioned) has also been talk of the town during the visit. The locals only complained about the transfer of PMAY-G cases to PMAY-Urban and awaiting sanction and disbursement. The visit ended with high spirits.

The high school lacks basic facility of water filter to provide safe drinking water to children. The middle school and pry school operating from same premises are in a very dilapidated condition. Washrooms are stinking dilapidated which need immediate attention. 5. Lastly, the hospital building built from KLC funds should be utilized properly as it is highly un-utilised and only one health and Wellness Centre is operating from it. The demand of public is to upgrade the same to PHC. The building also requires roofing with additional work in its second story.
