Some important issues raised during
B2 VS and needs to be addressed ~~for~~ for
the betterment of the Panchayat :-

- 1) Since Fazlabad is a productive belt from
agriculture point of view and mostly 80% population
engaged in Agriculture, the productivity depends
on the irrigation potential available in the area.

The irrigation canal which starts from Fazlabad
Bathua and runs upto Lower Fazlabad approximately
spanning 2 kms. urgently and immediately require
repairing work as well as desilting. It should be
done on priority basis by involving the state
Irrigation Department as issue pertains to this
Department. The canal is locally called 'Shahi koot'.

- 2) The general public in large demanded that the local
Staff posted in different departments should be atleast
transferred to other blocks of district in order to bring
accountability of the employees and to curb the
corruption from the society.

- 3) PRI/Sarpanch demand immediate release funds
of pending work done during 2020-21 and
2021-22 as in most cases material / skill
labour cost has not been yet been released.
It needs to be addressed.

- 4) One Dispensary in Panchayat is required as
the PHC operating in area is about 3 km from
the Panchayat.

- 5) Water tank required near Ziarat Kabassthaw in Ward No-4-
- 6) One primary school required in Ward No 1
- 7) Out of the 7 wards of Panchayat Fazlabad only 3 Anganwadi Centres are working in 1, 3 and 6 wards. In other panchayats one Anganwadi Centre each required in Ward No 2, Ward No 4, Ward No 5 and Ward No 7 as each Ward is about 1-2 km away from other Ward.
- 8) Public washroom/Toilet and one hand Pump is required in Ward No. 3 as this Ward has Fazlabad main market where people from all these come to market.
- 9) 70 Nos. of Electric Poles required in the Panchayat
- 10) 3 Nos. of transformers required of 63kws. as reported by the PRI and general public

- 1) Play ground required in the High School
- 2) Upgradation of existing Govt High school to Higher Secondary School with Science faculty as the students have either to go Bughies or Sikanote for higher education.
