GRAM PANCHAYAT PLAN

Toady on 15-11-2023 a meeting of Gram Panchayat in Panchayat Lowrer Murrah Kulali of B2V5 programme held under the supervision of Visiting Officer Sh. Mohd Shakoor Sr. Lecturer in community Hall Kulali in presence of Sarpanch, Panches, executives of different departments and general public.

In the meeting the following issues/demands and GPDP Plan has been framed: -

- 1. Jal Shakti Department: -
 - Urgent major repairs are needed for old damaged pipelines, causing distress among residents.
 - Extension of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) schemes is necessary for improved water facilities.
- 2. PDD Department: -
 - Approximately 50% of areas in Pyt. lack electricity infrastructure (poles, wires, and Transformers), affecting Mohalla Janni Dana, Baracharan, Dophally, and Kalawan.
- 3. Sheep and Animal Husbandry Department:
 - a. The performance of the Sheep and Animal Husbandry Department is unsatisfactory, especially for the tribal population dependent on it. Moreover, Trained official are required to provide medicine timely.
- 4. RDD:
 - a. Panchayat Ghar building remains unprovided despite repeated demands.
 - Incomplete Jollah Bridge and two tractor roads are causing inconvenience to the residents.
- 5. Education Department:-
 - Schools in far-flung areas, including HS Murrah, MS Dophally, PS Nanoor Wala, and PS Janni Dana, lack proper infrastructure and toilet facilities.
 - Insufficient teaching staff is hindering the delivery of quality education particularly in HS Murrah.
- 6. PMGSY and PWD:
 - a. Only 20% of Pyt. areas are connected with roads, with 80% pending. Hill Kaka roads project has been stalled for one and a half years without any communication from the UT administration.
 - Urgent action is needed for a 5 km road from Loan Gali to Danna Margh Sikar Gali to connect four more wards, fulfilling the demands raised during all phases of B2 Village programs.

These concerns require immediate attention to enhance the well-being and development of the Lower Murrah Kulali Panchayat.

Subject: Report on Performance Issues in B2V5 Program Departments

Respected [Higher Authorities]

I am writing to bring to your attention the concerning performance issues observed in several departments under the B2V5 Program. The following departments have shown significant shortcomings:

- 1. Animal and Sheep Husbandry Department: -
 - Lack of camps
 - Absence of trained officials
 - Delay in providing essential medicines
- This is particularly distressing as the entire tribal population is dependent on this department.
- 2. Agriculture Department: -
 - Inadequate awareness about different schemes
 - Absence of reports on Kisan Credit Card (KCC) coverage
- 3. Sericulture Department: -
 - Non-existence of the department
 - No database provided for necessary functions
- 4. PMGSY and PWD: -
 - Failure to provide plans and progress reports
 - Pending road projects from B2V3/B2V4

These issues are critical, impacting the livelihoods and well-being of the local population. Urgent attention and intervention are needed to rectify these deficiencies and ensure the effective implementation of the B2V5 Program.


